

Best Real Estate Report

ENTRIES CLOSE: Monday 2 November 2009

Judging criteria

The 2010 REIQ Award for Excellence Best Real Estate Report will be judged on journalistic excellence including newsworthiness, understanding and analysis of issues impacting the real estate industry, research, writing, creativity, public benefit and production.

This award rewards excellence in real estate reporting and therefore entries are not required to mention the REIQ.

Each entry can include up to three reports. A group entry may include work of up to five people, with all names included on the entry form.

Conditions of entry

Entries must have been published or broadcast in Queensland during the period 1 November 2008 and 30 October 2009.

All entries must be verified by a representative of the entrants' media organisation.

A 300-word (maximum) statement can be included in your entry outlining the genesis of the report(s).

Print (including online)

One full-size high quality copy of tear-sheets or webpages are required to be submitted which show each report included your entry.

Broadcast (radio and television)

Report(s) need to be saved onto a CD or DVD which must be labelled with your name, and the number and names of stories on the disk.

Judging panel

The judging panel will include two senior Queensland media professionals as well as property industry representatives.

Gala awards night

Finalists will receive one complimentary invitation to attend the REIQ's Awards of Excellence gala to be held at the Sofitel Brisbane in February 2010.
